Dj Crumbz was born Charles Sheppard in the Pico-Union area of Los Angeles, CA. Crumbz grew up to a variety of music thanks to his older sister's love of Disco and Funk, his mother and aunt's Spanish influence, and his father's collection of Country and Blues. After spinning at many house parties, DJ Crumbz knew he had to take the next step. He later began spinning at local Hollywood and South Bay hot spots. DJ Crumbz has never established a set playlist for any occasion but feeds off of the crowd at any given moment.

His radio career began in 2005 at SBS Los Angeles (KXOL-Latino 96.3fm). He worked as a producer and on-air mixer and soon added, on-air jock to his resume. After 2 years of experience and feeling confident with his talent, it was time for a move. The move included relocating his career and submitting himself to a culture shock in Memphis, TN. Immediately after his arrival, he was welcomed to the Flynn family (WHBQ -Q107.5FM).
